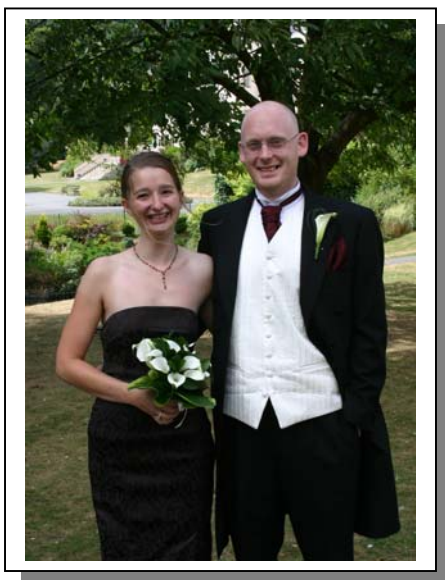
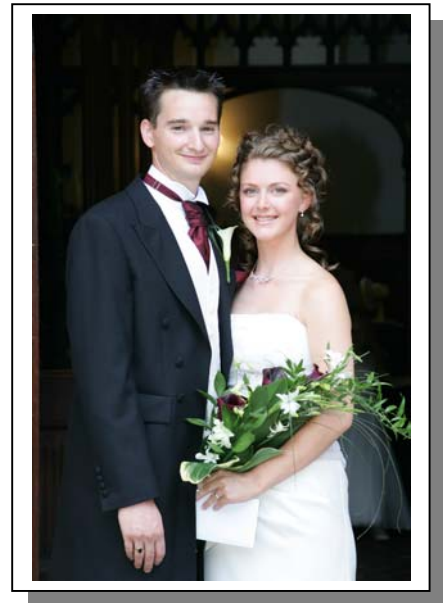
Merry Christmas to everyone...
